Electrolux named Industry Leader in RobecoSAM annual rating

Electrolux has, for the third consecutive year, been ranked as Industry Leader Household Durables in RobecoSAM's Sustainability Yearbook, an annual rating of companies' sustainability performance.

The yearbook looks back at companies' sustainability performance in 2013 and ranks them as Gold, Silver or Bronze. The top performing company from each of 59 industries is named RobecoSAM Industry Leader. Electrolux received the highest rating of the ten companies assessed within the Household Durables industry and consequently also the Gold Class award.

"To reach our vision of being the best appliance company in the world, we also need to be leading in sustainability," said Henrik Sundström, Vice President Group Sustainability Affairs at Electrolux. RobecoSAM said in the yearbook it had measured companies based on their sustainability performance in three dimensions: economic, environmental and social.
