Management change in AB Electrolux

Stockholm, Sweden, March 2, 2015

Gunilla Nordström, Head of Major Appliances Asia Pacific and Executive Vice President of AB Electrolux, will leave Electrolux in order to pursue other interests. Electrolux has recruited Kenneth L. Ng, currently CEO of Lixil Corporation in Greater China, as new head of the business area. He will join Electrolux April 1st.

Born in the United States, he holds MBA and B.S. degrees in marketing from New York University.

Gunilla Nordström joined Electrolux in 2007 after a long career with Ericsson and Sony Ericsson in Asia, Europe and Latin America. She is a board member in Atlas Copco AB since 2010 and Wärtsilä Corporation since 2012.
