

Electrolux Group sustainability and policy influence

Electrolux Group participates in various activities to inform and influence legislators and government officials on sustainability-related topics that are important to the Group.

In most cases, activities to inform and influence legislators and government officials on sustainability-related topics are performed together with industry partners through national or regional trade and industry associations where Electrolux Group is a member.

In some limited cases, Electrolux Group conducts direct lobbying, for example when an issue is particularly important to the Group or when its position is different to that of the industry association. Electrolux Group does not give any contributions to political campaigns, organizations or candidates in any country or region.

The most important topics for direct and indirect legislative influence during 2022 were energy efficiency legislation, carbon border adjustment mechanisms, recycling, circular economy and chemical legislation.
